BREAKFAST IN WEST END

Start the day with a hearty and healthy breakfast in West End. The delicious fare matches the eclectic nature of the suburb – think fresh produce, organically-grown, quirky and original dishes that are seriously delectable. Walk off breakfast afterwards via a stroll to nearby South Bank.



2 GET ACTIVE

Adventure awaits in the city. Grab a paddle and take to the river in a kayak at Riverlife, right under the Kangaroo Point Cliffs. Or join them for rock climbing and abseiling on the cliffs. Feeling zippy? Hire a unique Urb-E foldable electric scooter and zip across the Riverwalk to Howard Smith Wharves.



3 CLIMB THE STORY BRIDGE

Take your visit to Brisbane to new heights. Climb to the top of the **Story Bridge** and savour views over the river, city and out to Moreton Bay. Romantics will love a sunset climb. Or add some adrenaline to your climbing adventure by abseiling down one of the bridge's pylons.

Once at Howard Smith Wharves, it's time to slow down. Relax on the grass with views of the river, Story Bridge and city skyline. Or sample a brew from the precinct's brewery, right on the boardwalk above the river. A divine overwater bar and fine-dining options are other tempting offerings here.



5 EAT LIKE A KING

King Street is a wonderfully funky thoroughfare with a diverse range of eating and drinking options. Choose from Vietnamese, Texan-Mexican, Italian, French and Japanese or chow down on Chinese dumplings, Korean-style fried chicken, bountiful burgers, plentiful pizzas and more. Food trucks and a Bayarian beer hall add to the mix.


